



POOL PARTY QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

June 22, 2020

Question:

How many people can attend a pool party?

Answer:

150 (one hundred and fifty) individuals. The Directed Health Measures (DHM) requires that we limit the pool to 75% of our occupancy. For Sunny Slope Pool – that is 150 (one hundred and fifty) individuals.

Question:

What are the social distancing rules?

Answer:

The DHM requires that groups at the pool can be no larger than six (8) individuals and six (6) feet separation between groups is suggested – both on deck and in the pool.

The member scheduling the party is accountable for communicating this to the party guests and for complying with these rules.

Question:

Can we bring in outside food for a pool party?

Answer:

The DHM requires that self-serve buffets are prohibited. Our interpretation of the rule is that pot-luck style food will be prohibited. Prepared and packaged food will be allowed. Examples include: pizza, individual chip bags, etc...

Additionally, the DHR requires that staff must serve food directly to all individuals. Our interpretation of the rule is that the member scheduling the party is accountable for ensuring that food is served to party guests.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Parties must be scheduled through the pool manager or assistant manager**
- **Parties cannot be scheduled on Memorial Day, July 4th or Labor Day**
- **Parties must comply with the current Directed Health Measures and Sunny Slope Pool Rules**
- **Party guests and members that fail to comply with the DHM or Sunny Slope Pool Rules will be asked to leave the pool and party fees will not be refunded**
